- Provide advice on reinsurance submissions contract terms and liaise with company management.
- Liaise with brokers and clients regarding reinsurance agreement terms and conditions.
- Liaise with clients and other relevant parties to ensure timeliness of transactions and that deadlines are met.
- Ensure appropriate sign-off on underwriting documents and that accurate information is maintained in the underwriting systems.
- Prepare and review ad hoc underwriting reports as directed.
- Other responsibilities as needed to ensure quality client service.

- Ideally a minimum of 8 years of experience in the Re/Insurance industry.
- CPCU, ARe, ACII or other equivalent professional designations preferred.
- Extensive knowledge of Property treaty reinsurance and primary insurance standards, practices and principles.
- Strong knowledge of specific contract features.
- Experience in reinsurance/property catastrophe broking, underwriting or on a contracts team beneficial.
- Proficient skills in Microsoft Office suite.
- Strong organizational skills and ability to meet deadlines under pressure.
- Enthusiastic and strongly motivated self-starter.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- Very high attention to detail and accuracy.
- Ability to work independently and collaborate with colleagues within and across departments and time-zones.
